Where do I go after Rehab????

In today's economy of difficult budgets and cut backs where does this place those of us that are looking for active solutions to solve problems and stumbling blocks in our path of recovery?

Today traditional rehab as we knew it; is over. Length of stay and programming have been drastically cut back. In the past rehabs helped those with problems of Alcohol and Addiction for periods ranging from 30 days to 90 days 6 months to a year then putting them into step down programs such as Intensive outpatient and/or ¾ housing programs. Today those seeking rehabilitation help are allotted a stay of approximately 14 days, in many cases less. Chances are you know someone that suffers from the disease of addiction and/or alcoholism.

Question to most of us that complete rehab: **Where do I go when I finish Rehab?**

This is a Crossroads. The options for those on the path of Recovery are getting smaller and smaller. In most cases what brought us to rehabs are the exact same reasons we cannot go back to where we came from, living situations, family of origin and questionable friends. **So where do we go after rehab?** Often; ¾ Housing or Recovery Home Programs. The difference now is the client has little knowledge, routine or support after leaving rehab after only a few days. We find an insurgence of those coming to our Program needing more help and support. We have added additional programming to help this population. Without support by our agency or others like us, Recovery falls of for the vast majority.
